Duration

Half a day to a full day and really worth more than one visit during your stay.

Itinerary

- 1. Take the train eastbound from Saltash Station to Plymouth North Road station and walk down Armada Way to the City Centre.
- 2. Alternatively catch one of the numerous buses from the bottom of Saltash Fore St. to royal Parade in the City Centre.
- 3. From the City Centre, follow the signs to the Barbican and just follow the waterfront around via the Hoe. Take in the sumptuous vista. Follow the waterfront around to Devil's Point and the Hamoaze at the mouth of the River Tamar and then take the rear entrance into the Royal William Yard. The Seco Lounge is nice for a coffee and croissant.
- 4. Take a bus form the main entrance of The Royal William Yard back to Royal Parade.
- 5. Return by train, bus or perhaps even a taxi after a late night visit to the Theatre Royal.

Food and Drink stops

- Numerous pubs, restaurants, cafés and hotels.
- The Royal William Yard offers a wide range of eating houses in a wonderful waterside setting.

Tips.....

- 1. Check the tide times to get the full waterfront experience. Places look even better with the tides in!
- 2. Check rail and bus timetables to make sure you make your planned connections.
- 3. Consider a ferry trip to Mount Batten or across Plymouth Sound to Kingsand and Cawsand.
- 4. Consider taking a river trips from the Barbican up the River Tamar or River Yealm.
- 5. If it's a rainy then think about going to the Drake Circus shopping Mall, The Barcode entertainment centre next door, The Box Museum and Gallery or the The National Marine Aquarium.
