Duration

For as long as you choose.

Itinerary

1. If you are staying at the bungalow then turn left and walk down to the crossroads and then left again up and over the hill down to the CFCC.
2. If you are staying in the caravan park then just turn left at the entrance and walk down the hill to the CFCC.
3. Walk through the complex to the Golf Driving Range turning right downhill towards the river.
4. Follow the path along the lower side of the Range bearing right near the end of the range to follow the woodland path.
5. Follow this path for as far as you can. It will lead out onto a derelict quay on Kingsmill Creek, a tributary of the River Tamar. Sit down and enjoy the views and birdlife.

6. Retrace your steps and return to the CFCC for refreshments.
7. Alternatively, walk down past the Crazy Golf Course to a quiet spot overlooking the river.

- Take your camera and binoculars.
- The views are nicer when the tide is in, but the bird-watching better with the tide is out.
- Estuary birds you can expect to see include Curlew, Whimbrel, Redshank, Greenshank, Common Sandpiper, Dunlin, Little Egret, Heron, Oystercatcher, Mallard, Shelduck, Cormorant, Terns and Gulls.
