Itinerary

1. Catch the train from Saltash railway station westwards to St. Austell station.
2. Buses run regularly from St Austell bus station which to Charlestown. Locals recommend the route number 24, First Kernow. More information can be found on the First Group here: <https://www.firstgroup.com/cornwall>
3. The bus station is next to the railway station.
4. Return Charlestown to St Austell railway station and thence by rail to Saltash.
