## Discovery Adventure Green Travel Trip: 15

Bus trip via Plymouth to Newton Ferrers and Noss Mayo for coastal and River Yealm walk.  
There is a river cruise alternative.



*A trip to the charming riverside settlements of "Newton and Noss" one of the choicest residential areas of the South Hams. A circular walk which has it all – luscious countryside plus superb coastal and estuary views. Definitely one for a picnic break en-route.*

*Numerous Luncheon venues*

*Suitable for children 5yo + however if walking beware that the first section is steep.*

### Duration

A full day.

### Itinerary

1. Take the train eastbound from Saltash Station to Plymouth North Road station and walk down Armada Way to the City Centre.
2. Alternatively catch one of the numerous buses from the bottom of Saltash Fore St. to Royal Parade in the City Centre.
3. Catch the No.94 bus from bus stop A11 to Newton and Noss. Alight at Noss Mayo for the walk.
4. Return by bus to Royal Parade Plymouth and thence to Saltash.

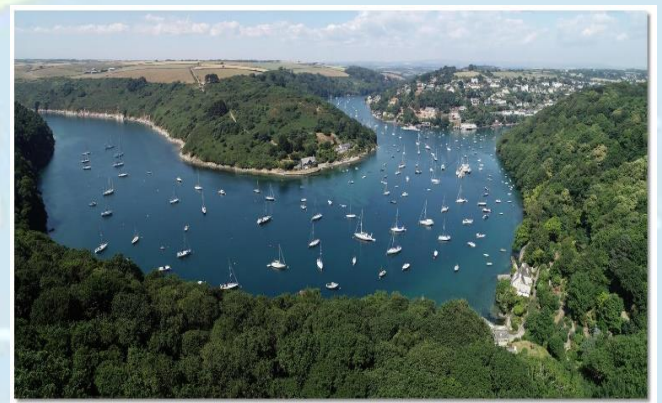
## Food and Drink stops

The Ship Inn, Noss Mayo. – Recommended for a meal or local cider at the end of your walk.

## Tips

- Double check your rail and bus connections before setting out.
- Make sure the trains stop at Saltash.
- The coastal walk is highly recommended. Beware of the steep climb out of the village to the coast.
- As an alternative, consider a boat trip from Plymouth Barbican out across Plymouth Sound and into the River Yealm.
