Train to Newton Abbot transferring to the Paignton branch-line then by steam train to Kingswear and Dartmouth via passenger ferry. Option to stop off at "Greenway" the country home of Agatha Christie (National Trust).

Duration

A full day.

Itinerary

1. Catch the train eastbound from Saltash railway station eastwards to Newton Abbot station.
2. Transfer to the Paignton branch line alighting at Paignton station.
3. Catch the Dartmouth steam railway to Kingswear catching the pedestrian ferry across to Dartmouth.
4. Return to Paignton and then Newton Abbot station and thence by rail to Saltash.

Food and Drink stops

- Numerous en route and in particular in Dartmouth.
- Greenway House, National Trust.

Tips

1. Double check your rail connections and times before setting out.
2. Greenway, the country home is set in the most beautiful of riverside settings and well worth a detour to explore the house and woodland gardens. NT food and drink on site.
3. You can take a short ferry trip from the quay at Greenway across to the village of Dittisham.
4. River trips also available form Dartmouth.
5. The annual Dartmouth Royal Regatta adds to the spectacle as does a walk to Dartmouth Castle.
