## Discovery Adventure Green Travel Trip: 11

Train to the seaside towns of Dawlish, Teignmouth and Shaldon with coastal footpath and beaching options.

*Suitable for children 5yo +*

Duration

A full day.

Itinerary

1. Catch the train eastbound from Saltash railway station eastwards to Dawlish or Teignmouth Stations depending on your plans for the day.
2. Walk along the SW Coastal footpath between the two including a long section of the sea wall or bus between the two towns.
3. A further ferry option from Teignmouth to Shaldon across the Teign estuary to take in the coastal views, small zoo or secret beach through the "smugglers" tunnel.
4. Return via Dawlish or Teignmouth stations by rail to Saltash.

## Food and Drink stops

1. Double check your rail connections and times before setting out.
